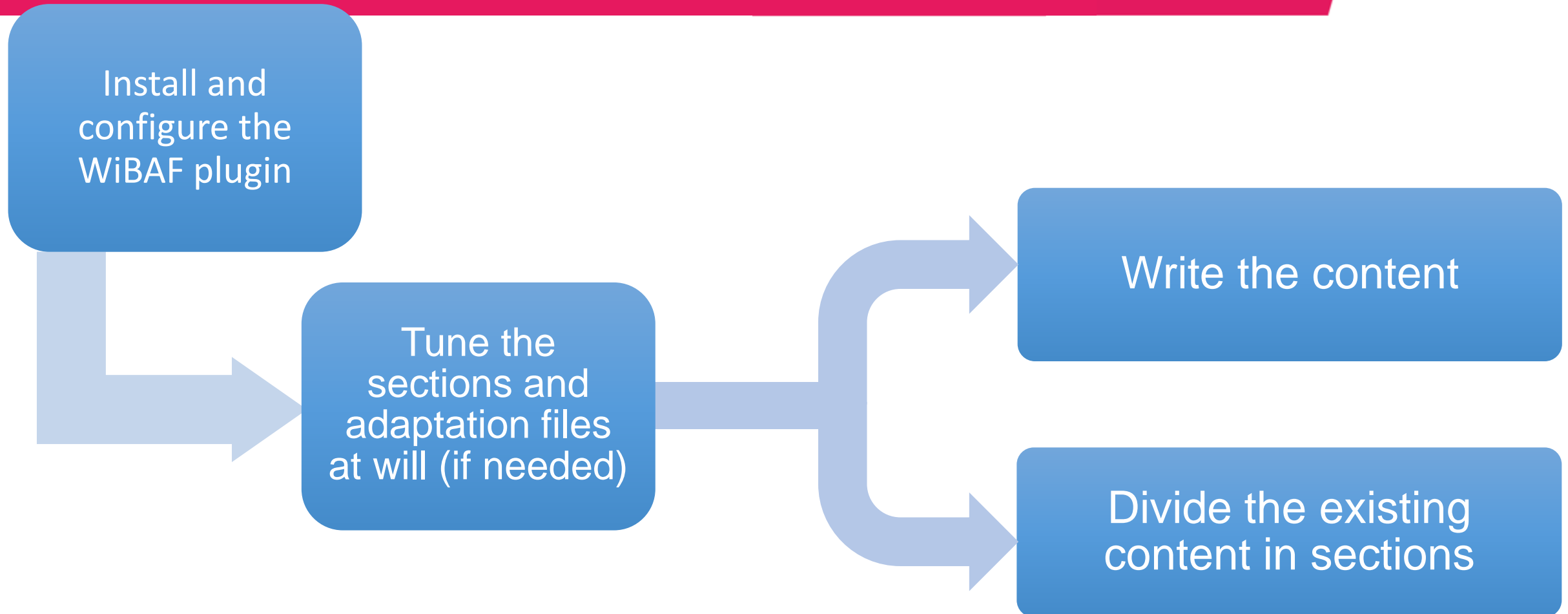

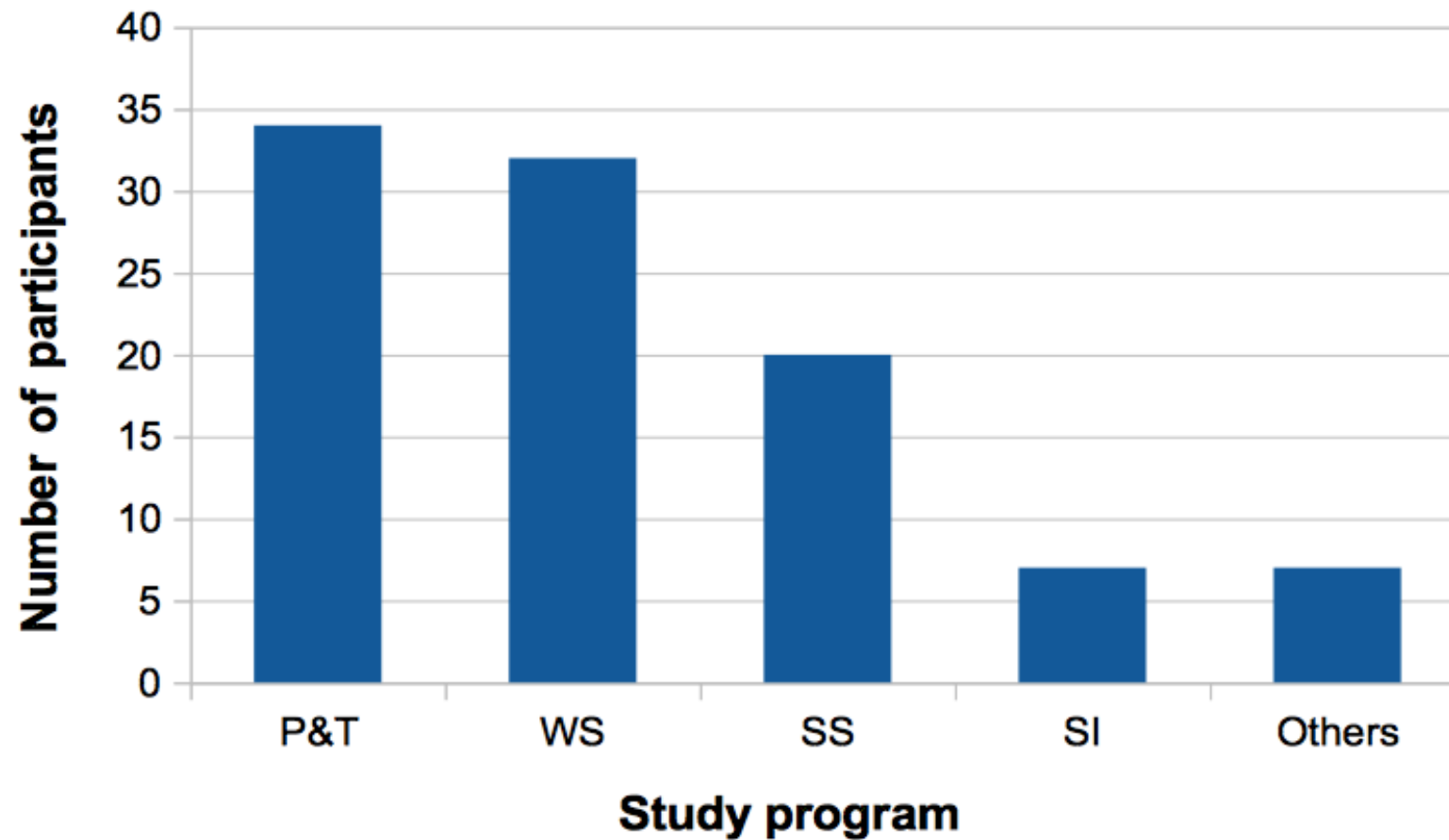

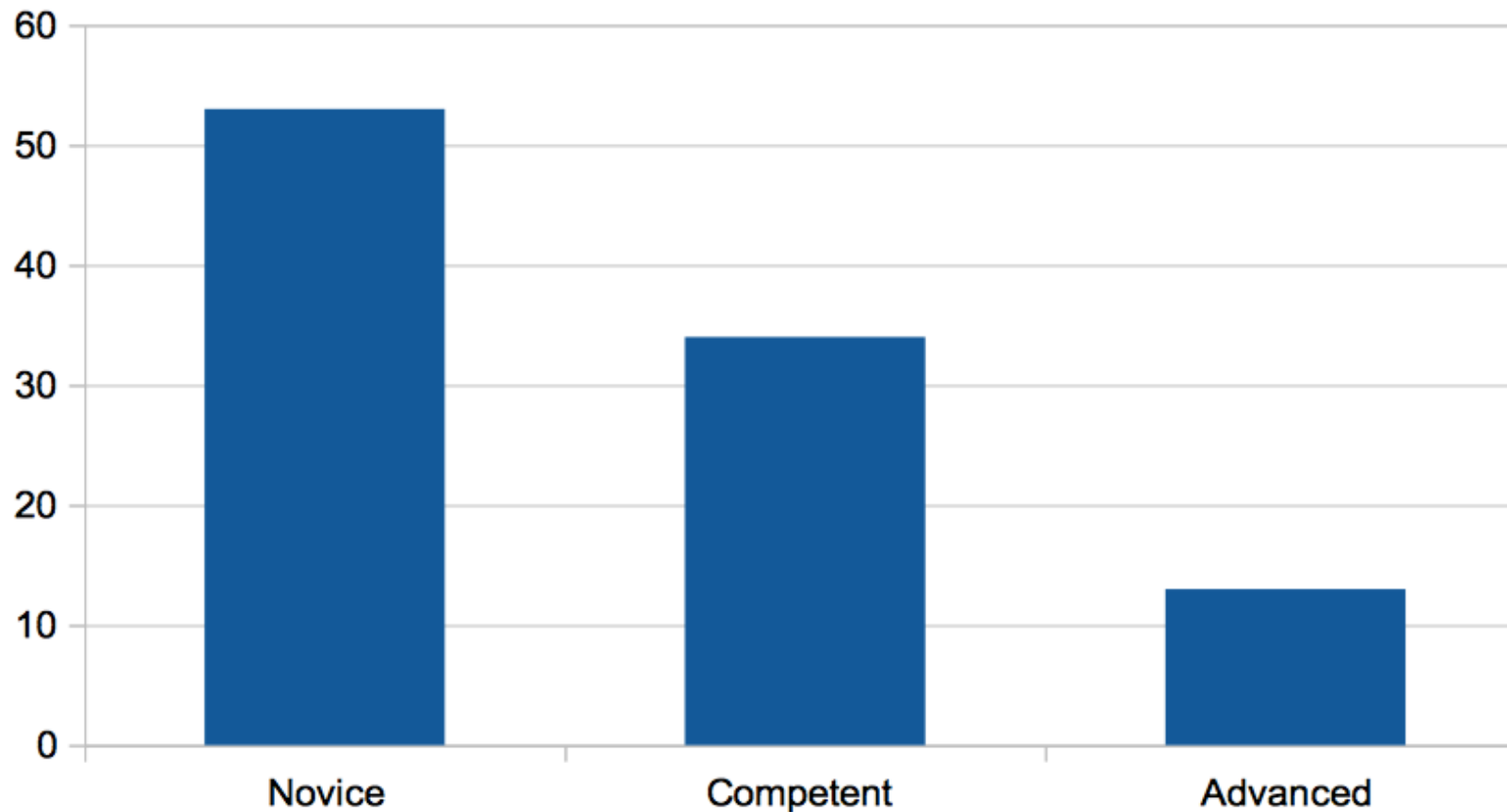

Evaluation with students: Students Population

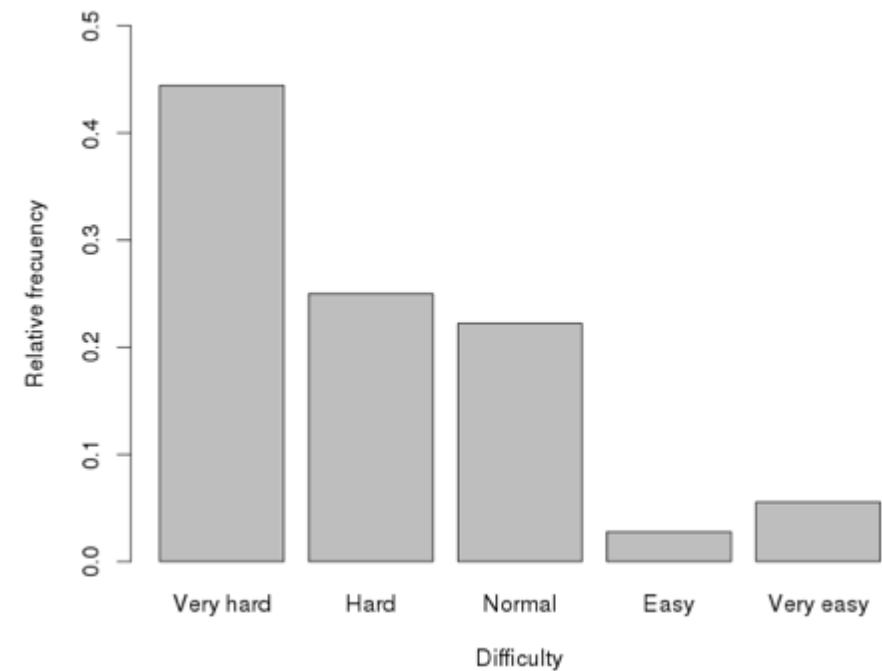


Evaluation with students: (Self-estimated) Knowledge of HTML



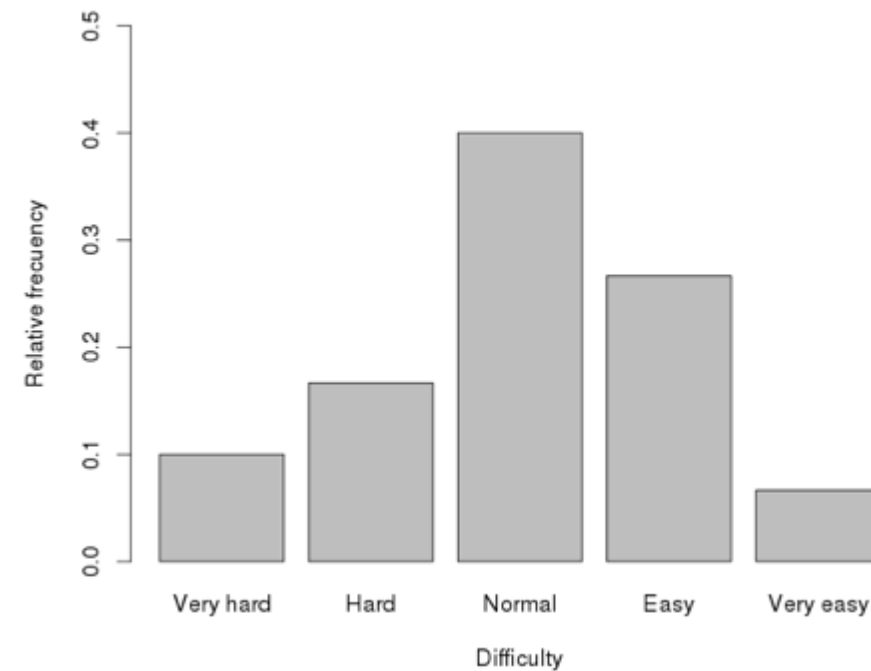
Evaluation with students

Evaluation with students

After installing and configured everything, the difficulty perceived by the students decreased significantly.



Lessons learnt

Using a CMS + an adaptation library eases the process of developing adaptive applications.

More work needs to be done to facilitate more interesting adaptation techniques.
